The following is in response to your request for a Safety Data Sheet (SDS) on **Avail** glovebags, Durapax disposal bags or D-Con enclosures.

The Department of Labor, Occupational Safety and Health Administration requires under 29 CFR 1910.1200, Hazard Communication Standard, that manufacturers assess and inform customers as to the hazards relating to chemicals in their products.

The item which you have requested an SDS on is an "article" as defined in Section (C) of the CFR: *Article* means a manufactured item other than a fluid or particle: (i) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture; (ii) which has end use function(s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use; and (iii) which under normal conditions of use does not release more than very small quantities, *e.g.*, minute or trace amounts of a hazardous chemical (as determined under paragraph (d) of this section), and does not pose a physical hazard or health risk to employees.

As the above mentioned articles do not release or otherwise result in exposure to a hazardous chemical under the conditions of your intended use, an SDS document is not required.
