To Whom It May Concern,

Tri-Dim Filter Corporation's filtration products do not require Material Safety Data Sheets. Filtration products are considered to be "articles" as defined in the Code of Federal Regulations.


The OSHA Regulation 29 CFR 1910.1200 section (a) paragraph (6)(v) defines "articles" as:

"...a manufactured item other than a fluid or particle: (i) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture; (ii) which has end use functions(s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during use; and (iii) which under normal conditions of use does not release more than very small quantities, e.g. minute or trace amounts of a hazardous chemical (as determined under paragraph (d) of this section), and does not pose a physical hazard or health risk to employees."

Therefore, since filtration products are considered to be articles, and the OSHA Hazard Communication Standard does not apply to articles, a Material Safety Data Sheet is not required.
